WHEN IS THE LUNCHEON THIS YEAR?

The annual fund raising luncheon of the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur will be held at the Cintas Center of Xavier University on Thursday, May 10th at 12:00 noon. The luncheon begins promptly at noon and ends at 1:00 p.m.

PURPOSES OF THE LUNCHEON

1. Communicating the mission and message of the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur.
2. In Cincinnati, the Sisters serve the community through a variety of ministries including:
 - Inner-city school programs, mentors and personalized reading courses
 - Adult education and parenting skills development
 - Rehabbed houses and home management programs for firsttime homebuyers
 - Providing basic employment skills and hope to those with poor track records in getting and keeping a job.
3. Identifying new prospects that may consider contributing to the mission of the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur.
4. Raising unrestricted operating funds to support the ongoing work of the Sisters of Notre Dame.

SUMMARY OF THE LUNCHEON

The brief, tightly scripted program is totally mission based. The emphasis is on the work of the sisters in inner-city Cincinnati.

Following the program, within the hour time frame, guests are invited to consider a gift, hopefully a five-year pledge. There is no effort to pressure or embarrass anyone. If people choose not to give a gift, no one pursues them. Over the past 7 years we have raised more than \$1.2 million.
